Looking for a single camp host that has experience in all areas of our job description or a couple that can split daily tasks in the office and grounds work.

Included with job: A lake front seasonal camp site with full hookups (propane not included), Wi-Fi, onsite use of a washer and dryer, a \$1,100 monthly salary (per person) and an end of the season bonus.

Work Schedule: Must be able to commit to the entire season May 21st – Sept 29th. Days/nights starting on Saturdays at 1:00pm (on call overnight), Sunday (on call overnight), Monday (on call overnight) and Tuesday. Days off Tuesday 4 or 5pm - Saturday at 1pm.

Work schedule depending on assigned work area for the day:

Working in office 9am-5pm or grounds 8am-4pm (hours may vary for grounds), being on call after office closes for late check-ins, closing of dumpster at dark and noise monitoring. On call hours may vary but should not exceed 1-2 hours per day. Being on call does require the host to remain present at the campground. Couples will be assigned both office and grounds on the same days. Single hosts may be assigned to office or grounds on scheduled workdays.

Requirements:

- Strong customer service skills
- Basic manual labor abilities, including an ability and willingness to clean and sanitize facilities
- Must be able to use a rake and shovel
- Must be able to lift 10 pounds
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Basic money handling skills
- Basic computer skills, including sending/receiving emails, printing and using a booking software program
- Must be able to work with minimal supervision and be able to learn quickly

On site salaried Camp Hosts are responsible for daily and weekly tasks which include but are not limited to:

- Maintains facilities and grounds, including cleaning, sanitizing and stocking bathhouse and porta potties, emptying trash containers, cleaning/raking roadways, cleaning campsites, picnic tables, fire rings and disposing of ashes.
- Rakes sites and public areas, maintains a litter free facility, picks up micro-trash such as bottle caps and cigarette butts.
- Directs sanitation truck once a week to empty seasonal RV tanks
- Make reservations via phone/in person and check emails for reservations/questions.
- Registers campers, collects fees and sells camp store items.
- Cleans and re stocks office inventory.
- Monitoring traffic entering the campground, all vehicles must have a seasonal sticker or parking pass
- Enforce rules of camp to seasonal and nightly guests
- Empty Recycle bins/dog waste bins.
- Open at 8am/close dumpster at dark or 9pm
- Collect quarters from showers
- Maintain and clean golf carts.
- Clean beach area-Light raking
- Water grass
- Basic water system information
- Misc maintenance work (raking, weed whacking, and mowing)
- Work well with others and help keep our beautiful campground clean and safe.
- Additional work may be needed.
